The Defense Health Agency (DHA) military medical libraries have a one month trial access to OvidMD, Wolters Kluwer integrated search platform for Ovid and UpToDate content. OvidMD is the first clinical tool from Ovid that provides quick answers to clinical questions based on relevant full-text content from Ovid. OvidMD fills a clinical information gap between point-of-care tools and in-depth medical research, when a clinician has time to search for relevant answers in the literature. OvidMD provides access to subscribed Ovid full-text ejournals and clinically-relevant ebooks, Ovid MEDLINE, UpToDate, CME credit, Evidence-Based Clinical Guidelines, A-Z Drug Facts, national guidelines, patient education, and medical calculators PLUS your clinically relevant full-text content ~ the ejournals, ebooks, and databases that you rely on when searching OvidSP.

We are offering trial access to OvidMD so that you can take a "test drive" and make it available to your local organization. Please provide your comments on OvidMD so we can provide feedback to the DHA Clinical Portfolio Management Board, the governance body for the Virtual Medical Library Integrated Product Team (DMVL IPT). The Team includes representatives from the Army, Air Force, and Navy medical library programs as well as the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences Learning Resource Center, Defense Medical Virtual Library, and the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center Medical Library.
